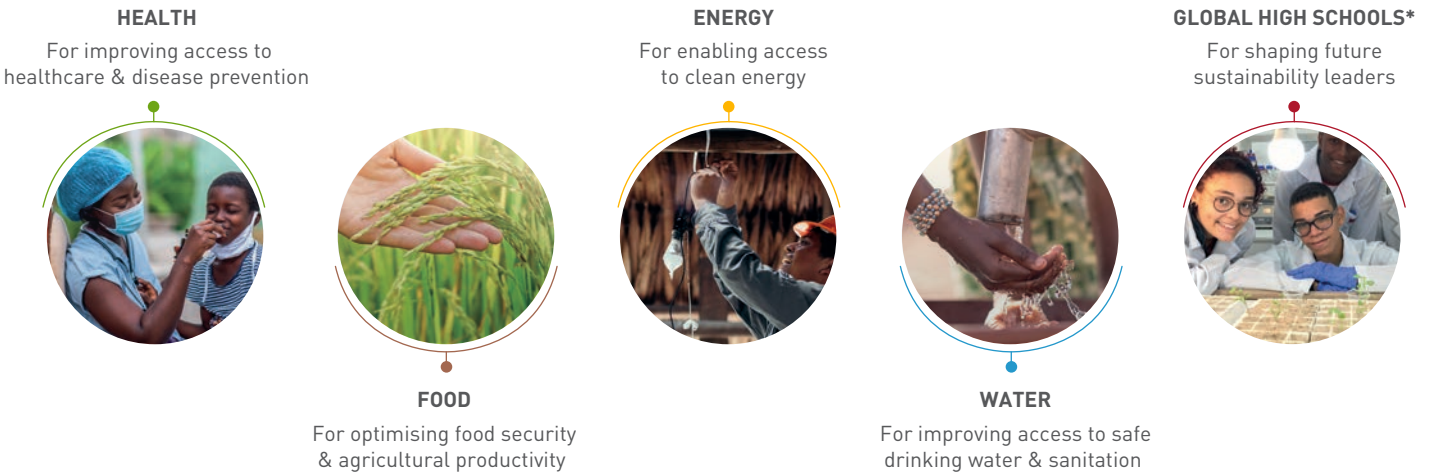
The launch of the submissions phase for the 2022 awards cycle has begun and will run until **6th May 2021**.

Established in 2008, the Zayed Sustainability Prize was created to honour the legacy of the UAE's Founding Father, Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, and carry forward his commitment to sustainability and humanitarianism.

Over the past 12 years, the Prize has awarded **86 winners**. Collectively, they have, directly and indirectly, positively impacted the lives of over **352 million people** around the world.

Prize Categories

US\$ 600,000 per category



*The Global High Schools category awards six schools from six world regions up to US \$100,000 each. Those regions are the Americas, Sub-Saharan Africa, Middle East & North Africa, Europe & Central Asia, South Asia, and East Asia & Pacific.
