
The Science Island Express delivers the most recent happening at HFIPS.

On April 12, the first 403-second steady-state H-mode plasma was achieved on Experimental Advanced Superconducting Tokamak, one of HFIPS's scientific facility, setting a new record of pulse length on high performance operation in tokamaks. On the second day, the operational scenario was repeated, demonstrating the reliable capability of the device.

HFIPS researchers sandwiched hexagonal boron nitrid as a gap spacer in a nanoparticle-on-mirror structure to effectively block electron tunneling, an effect weakening the surface-enhanced Raman spectroscopy detection.
